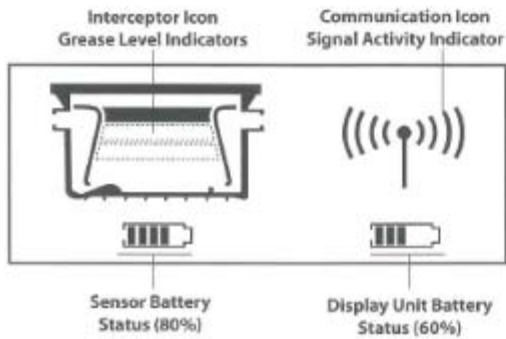

DUAL MONITORING:

The Endura Sentry monitors your grease interceptor in two ways. The first is based on grease accumulation against rated capacity, set using the dipswitches on the Display Unit accordingly. As the FOG (Fat, Oil and Grease) accumulates, the monitor tracks this changing the display and activating the alarm accordingly.

The second means of monitoring is time based. Based on best practice, no grease interceptor should operate for extended periods of time without servicing. Regardless of FOG accumulation Sentry will sound the alarm every 120 days (4 months) indicating the need for servicing. 
